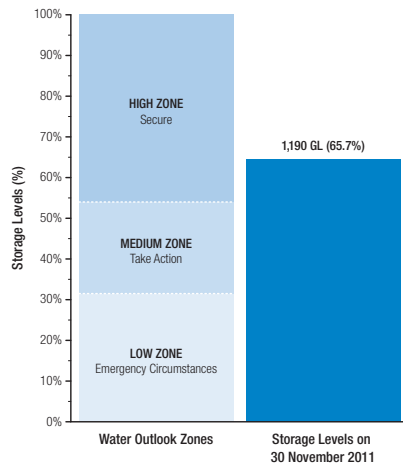


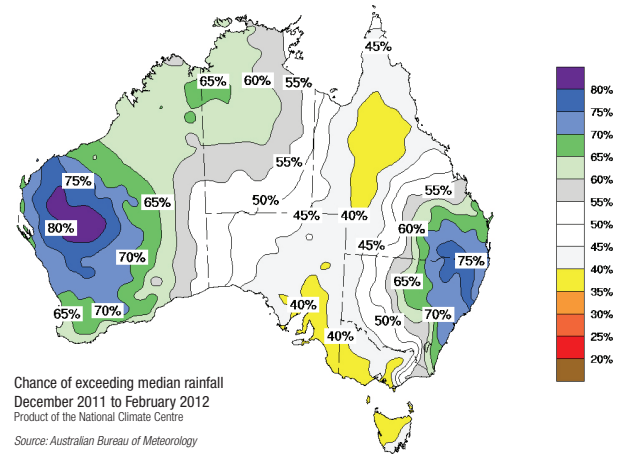
Water Outlook for Melbourne Snapshot

Current storage levels



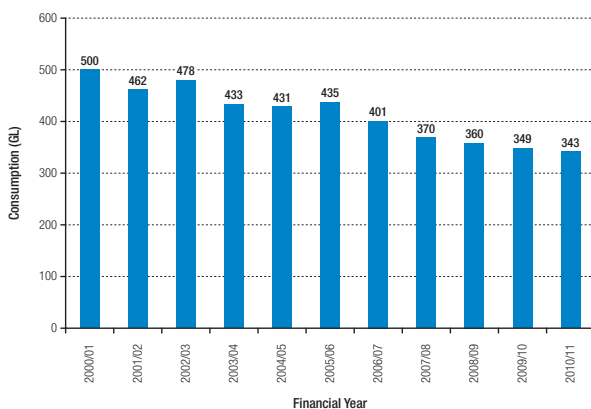
Melbourne's water storage level is 65.7% on 30 November 2011.

Seasonal rainfall outlook Dec 2011 – Feb 2012



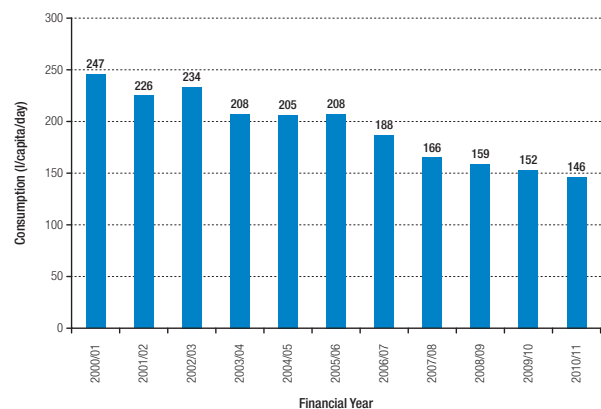
The latest Bureau of Meteorology seasonal climate outlook indicates the likelihood of below median rainfall and warmer temperatures over summer.

Securing supplies over the long term

Securing water supply is an ongoing task and there remains a need to continue investment in programs that can contribute to the long term security of supply.

Key programs to be implemented this year are presented opposite.

- Relaxing restrictions from Stage 2 to Stage 1.
- Continuation of household and business water efficiency programs.
- New guidelines to increase use of alternative water supplies under the Government's *Living Melbourne, Living Victoria* policy.
